*Participants may enter up to 3 different cultivars in most classes except those marked with an asterisk. Please name each cultivar, if possible.

SECTION A: Narcissus (Daffodil) foliage is not attached

Class

1. Long Trumpet (e.g. King Alfred)-1 stem
2. Large cupped-1 stem
3. Small cupped-1 stem
4. Double bloom-yellow, 1 stem
5. Double bloom-white-1 stem
6. Miniature-3 stems
7. Any other species - 1 stem
8. Collections, in a vase, minimum of 5 stems

SECTION B: Tulips (should have 1 set of leaves)

Class

1. Single-1 colour, 1 stem
2. Double-1 stem
3. Any other tulip (e.g. lily flowered, parrot, etc.) 1 stem

SECTION C:

Class

1. Hyacinth-1 stem
2. Any other spring bulb – 1 stem

SECTION D:

Class

1. Allium, 1 large stem
2. Allium, 3 small stems

SECTION E:

Class

1. Collection of spring flowers in a vase. Minimum of 3 varieties

SECTION F:

Class

1. Iris – 1 spike, any type or colour, no foliage
2. Flowering shrub, in bloom, 1 branch, not to exceed 30 inches

SECTION G: HOUSEPLANTS

Class

1. African Violet-single
2. African Violet-double
3. Any houseplant in bloom-named
4. Any houseplant grown mainly for foliage-named
5. Cactus: any type, named
6. Succulent: any type, named
7. Orchid: any type, named

SECTION H: DESIGN/ARRANGEMENTS

Class

1. Any arrangement using branches
2. Any arrangement using a combination of spring flowers
3. ***Ikebana*** (meaning beautiful). A Japanese design using 3 spring blooms of any one variety

SECTION I: FRUITS AND VEGETABLES

Class

1. Any spring fruit or vegetable-3 specimens
